North  $\frac{1}{2}$  Lot 2, Concession 6, Sydenham Township

This farm is situated on the N  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 2, Concession 6, Sydenham Township and contains one hundred acres. In 1907 John and Malcolm McEachern took it from the Crown and in 1910 it was transferred to Malcolm McEachern from the John McEachern estate. Neil Morrison bought the land in 1923 and in 1930 Mary C. Morrison became the owner. She sold the farm to George Knox in 1931. Fraser Ramage and his wife, Olive lived on this farm for several years and in 1944 it was sold to Mr. and Mrs. Robert McLean by the George Knox estate. They carried on mixed farming. About 1953 the barn was burned by lightning. Later it was rebuilt. Mr. and Mrs. (Ronald and Patricia) Sword bought the farm in 1965 and they are the present owners. They have two daughters, Rhonda and Leeanne.

## Addition 1989

In 1982 Mr. and Mrs. Sword held an auction sale and moved to Owen Sound. The property was sold to Mr. and Mrs. John Heasman of Meaford in February 1983. On February 28, 1986 John D. Heasman and his wife, Joan M., sold the property to William Hugh Rich and Mary Agnes (Bowes) Rich.
