This lot in Sydenham Township consisting of fifty acres was taken from the Crown by James McKessock in 1871 and it was purchased by William J. McKessock in 1892. At this time there was a log house and barn situated near the south-east corner of the property.

In 1905, James Martin purchased the fifty acres from William J. McKessock and he owned it until 1957 when Harold Martin became the owner.

The farm is used mainly for pasture, but it does include ten acres of bush.
