



CELEBRATES DEFERRED CENTENNIAL — Lack of observance of the centennial of Johnstone Church will be remedied on Sunday when special services there will mark its 110th year of existence as a congregation. Forty-five years ago on Sunday the pres-

ent church building was formally opened. Its walls echoed the voice of the late Principal Gandier of Knox College, Toronto, preacher of the day. Originally Presbyterian, it became a United Church following Church Union in 1924.



A cement step and a few wooden posts alone remain to mark the site where worshippers knelt in the old Daywood Church. It was demolished in 1937. It was a frame

structure built with vertical boards. Since 1878 Daywood has been aligned with Johnstone Church. In 1906 Annan and Leith became part of the four-point pastoral charge.
