Business and Industry and all places of amusement are requested to close on this day of mourning.

An official service of memorial will be held in the Auditorium of the Civic Arena at Eleven O'Clock in the forenoon, to which all organizations are requested to send representatives who will assemble at the Market Square not later than 10.15 a.m. At this time they will form up under the parade Sergeant-Major and will move off to parade at 10.30 a.m. to arrive at the Arena to be seated in time for service at 11.00 a.m.

Citizens are urged not to observe the day as a holiday but as a day of solemn mourning for the passing of a beloved sovereign.
