This farm was the home of Mr. and Mrs. Victor Allen for forty-three years. Here their family of three girls were born, grew up, and married. They are: Blanche May, Mrs. Arther McMillan; Grace Emily, Mrs. Thomas Vincent of Allenford; and Violet Joy, Mrs. William Lake, now on the homestead.

The farm was taken from the Crown in 1859 by George Ridoret. In the next twenty years it changed hands several times. Mr. Garrette was owner for a short time, and also Mr. Brisco. In 1876 Robert Linn bought it. Twelve years later his son William took over. He lived here for about twenty years. The Linns built the present house and barn and cleared most of the land. Wilso Lennox bought the farm in 1908, and five years later sold it to George Proctor.

In 1920 Victor Allen and his wife Reta bought this farm. Originally it contained 100 acres. Mr. Allen bought another 150 acres across the road in Sarawak later.

Victor Allen is a son of the late Joseph and Emily Allen of Keppel Township. Mrs. Allen is a daughter of the late Thomas and Hattie Bye of Sydenham Township. They were married on October 10th, 1917. Mr. Allen was a trustee of Cavell School for two years and secretary-treasurer for five years.
