

Willow Creek Farm

Lot 12, Concession 3, Sarawak Township.



This property, now approximately seventy acres originally extended from its present western boundary to the shore of Owen Sound Bay. Older residents remember encampments along the shore where the Indians lived in tepees. Besides basket-weaving they made many ornaments. A picture with a beaded frame made by them is a prized possession of one family in the community.

In November 1870 a road allowance, four rods wide, was granted along the northern boundary of the property.

In July 1871 land was granted for a road allowance, this road now concession three Sarawak.

Mr. Wm. Johnston, in April 1877 took over this property from the Crown.
