



Two years later, April 1879, the Cavell School site was purchased from Mr. Johnston for the sum of one dollar.

From time to time the portion bordering on the water was divided into lots and sold.

The remaining farm property has changed hands many times, the owners after Mr. Johnson being: Samuel Johnston, W.R. Barfoot, James E. Parsons, George E. Sharpe, George Harris, James Potter and in April 1919, once again W. R. Barfoot.



W.R. Barfoot and his wife, nee Janet Scott of Sarawak, had four children. They are Alberta of Owen Sound, Muriel (Mrs. Reginald Gardiner) of Owen Sound, Robert Scott Barfoot, R.R.2. Owen Sound and Vera (Mrs. Wm. Scott) of Rexdale.

In March 1945 the farm was purchased by the present owners Mr. and Mrs. Robert Scott Barfoot. Mrs. Barfoot nee Helen Isabelle MacKinnon, of Allenford, came to the community in September 1932 to teach at Cavell School.



Their family, two daughters, are Patrieia Lorraine (Mrs. Douglas Armstrong), An employee of the Royal Bank of Canada in London, and Joan Louise, a student at the University of Western Ontario, London. The three Armstrong children are Kirby, age twelve, Lisa, age eleven, and Andrea, age six.
