**Museum-on-Wheels Program**

Grey Roots Museum & Archives introduces our new Museum-on-Wheels program. This program is designed for those schools or groups who want to learn and explore our history, but perhaps cannot travel to Grey Roots to experience the exhibits in person.

Museum-on-Wheels offers exhibit-based programming that is designed to inspire and educate primary and secondary school students as well as seniors and adult groups. One of our experienced Heritage Interpreters comes to your location to guide you through one of our two programs.

Our hands-on program, *Spinning through Time*, based on our new exhibit *Spinning Through Time: The Dorothy and Harry Kirk Collection* (opening January 19, 2007), takes participants through the history and process of cleaning, carding, and spinning wool into yarn.

Our other program, *From Slavery to Freedom*, based on our award-winning exhibit of the same name (on display once more February 10, 2007), guides participants through a trip back in time to experience what life was like for the African Canadian settlers to this region. This program provides the opportunity to celebrate the lives and contributions made by African Canadians and their descendants through interactive presentations and creating their own symbols based on those used on the Underground Railroad. Each program is one and a half hours.

This program has limited availability, so booking early is encouraged. The Museum-on-Wheels program is available January through March.
