



The Stars come out at Grey Roots Museum & Archives!

Grey Roots Museum & Archives celebrates International Astronomy Week (April 16-22) with a week-long astronomy display by the Bruce County Astronomical Society, a presentation, and an outdoor Sky Tour.

The feature presentation for the week is on **Tuesday, April 17th at 8 p.m. in the Grey Roots Theatre**, where John Hlynialuk will be presenting the lecture entitled: **Celebrate Our Night Sky!** John is a very active local astronomer, retired science teacher, and one of the main founders of the Bruce County Astronomical Society. He is in continual demand as a guest speaker on astronomy as well as on other areas of science at a variety of venues in the area. He has also presented recently to these other area organizations: the Bluewater Association of Lifelong Learning, Sydenham Sportsmen Association, and the Owen Sound Field Naturalists. Last fall, he presented a series of astronomy lectures at the Blue Water District School Board's outdoor education near Warton.

His one hour audio visual presentation will conclude at 9 p.m. at which time it should be fully dark. Participants will then proceed outside for the outdoor Sky Tour! On hand will be 6 to 8 local astronomers with scopes and laser pointers to work with the attendees. In case of cloud-out, the Sky Tour will be Thursday, April 19th at 9 p.m. to explore the stars. The lecture portion will proceed rain or shine.

Free to Museum and Bruce County Astronomical Society Members. Regular admission is \$6.00 per adult; \$5.00 per senior; \$3.50 per child.
