We are pleased to announce our second annual Grey Roots Regional Histor!ca Fair this May 1, 2008. Four schools are participating: Meaford Community School; Hillcrest Elementary School; Riverforest Montessori and Clearview Montessori. 57 projects will be in the fair this year.

Histor!ca Fairs are a grand celebration of Canada's heritage, in the form of student history projects. Students in Grades 4 through 9, share their research, gain recognition for their achievements, and learn from others about the multi-cultural history of Canada. At the Histor!ca Fair they then proudly present their stories to visitors and the community.

One representative will be chosen to attend the National Histor!ca Fair in Victoria, B.C., July 7-14, 2008. Three participants will be chosen attend the Provincial Fair in Ottawa June 11-15, 2008. The provincial and national fairs are showcases of the best projects from Canada.

Additional awards include the: Grey County Archives Award, Grey Roots Museum Award, and Grey County Warden's Award; Archives of Ontario Award and Ontario Genealogy Society Award; CN Veterans Award, Hbc Explorers Award, RBC Aboriginal Heritage Award, & the Laurier La Pierre Medal. All participants will receive a certificate of appreciation and a one-time Family Pass to the museum and archives. Projects will be up for viewing until the end of Saturday. Come support these students, their teachers and schools as well as this program.
