

1898 Trout Diary Summary

Ben Falls went West Jan 1898

Jones arrived on noon train January 1st 1898 left for Griersville Feb 5th 1898

Preached just five weeks with two additions

Travel York baptized Jan 7th Geo Cox

restored Jan 30th

John Deegan house burned Feb 4

They built wood – shed and moved with it Mar 26-98

Jones started meeting at Griersville Feb 6 and closed March 13th with eleven additions Viz:- Alex Johnston, Bertha Austen, Mrs. Clinton Brown, Miss Johnston, Jimmie Smith, Mary Austen, and her mother, Miss Adams, John Davison, Dave Adams, & Miss McColeman,

He began preaching at Thornbury April 5th closed April 15, 98

He went to Toronto with James the morning of the 18th April\Returned May 21, 98

Will came home from Nashville May 7 – 98 on two o'clock train.

Left for Toronto May 16 – 98

Jones began Cape Rich meeting May 22 – 98, closed with 5 baptisms and about 7 returned that had been staying away. Those baptized were McCartney, Mr. & Mrs. Joseph Emery, John, also Percy Emery & Fred Boyle.

Will returned from Toronto June 17th

Jones began meeting at Griersville June 19, 1898 closed July 3 with two baptisms, Sam Petch and Harry Dougherty. He spoke for us July 10 – at Cape Rich July 17 at Griersville in morning July 24 here in evening Wednesday July 13 prayer meeting – a time when we will be tested.

Jones left for home July 27 – 98 went to Toronto thence to Beamsville, Smithville & St Catherines

Will & Emily started South on September 1 visiting in Toronto arriving in Detroit Sept 4th.

Leaving Detroit 20 September arriving in Nashville September 21st

We left Meaford the 29th September for Nashville where we arrived Oct 1st after spending a day in Detroit, some of us going to carries, some to Keenans, some to John Yorks.

John, Abbie & Maud left Nashville for Meaford, March 14, 1899, arriving at latter place Mar 18 – 99. James & I left Nashville Apr 26 arriving Meaford May 1 -99. Will & Emily left Nashville for Detroit June 1 – 99 in Detroit June 2 – 99, Left Detroit.

Mrs. Price Mallory from Carman here Jan 7.

Did green quilt – Jan 10 Emily's stuff

Caliste? & Fred Abercrombie married Jan 19

Tom, Annie & Lizzie got pictures Jan 24

Tom, Lizzie, Lily, Annie & James pictures

Mrs John Laycock here to tea Feb 1 – 98

Johnny Falls here Feb 7 – 98

Mr. Brian Spike son died Feb 8 – 98

Emily Wallace married Feb 9 – 98

James & Paul pictures Feb 14

Forks for Angie Feb 19 – 98

Tom & Lizzie off to Manitoba Feb 19 – 98

?Dr.Snelgrove died Feb. 22 James Stewart funeral March 7

James & Pauls pictures \$1.50 for seven

We left for Nashville Sept 29 took \$587.11 spent next day in Detroit at Carrie York's & Arrived in Nashville Sat evening Oct 1st

I was sick Oct 6 – to see doctor

Stanley & Norman Mallory came Oct 1st

John & Will sick Nov 2

Mrs. Whitelaw to leave Meaford Nov 8

Mrs. Wm Trout died Dec 30

S. M. Jones & D. H. Jackson came Dec 30
