Feb 18 – Emily, Hubert + Will Stirling came on Saturday The doctor home Friday night called Saturday sent beautiful flowers Will + Lib Fleming down on Sunday. Wills folks went home on Monday and oh my what an empty house John and Abbie with us as much as they could

I tried through all the trouble to keep up an interest in every day duties and after James had gone to gather up the broken threads and go on as he would like me to do, so I went to meeting + S School the first Sunday knowing it would only be harder to wait for an easier time. He went himself as long as he could sit up and even after that he did not want me to stay and wait on him but would have me fix him up on the couch put his medicine near him and say “Now you will go wont you” He always said if he could work on Saturday he would go to meeting on Sunday. He was always ready with his time talent + means to do what he could for the Master + I must try and carry on the work he has left as well as I can
