Falls left Alaska at noon Sep 30 1914 by short railway trip on Tanana Valley railway 14 miles to Chena thence by boat names Tanana on river same name to Whitehorse which was reached Oct 12, 1914 took White Pass railway to Skagway one day travel thence took boat Humbolt – to Seattle to Detroit 5 ½ days stayed over one day in Chicago then a few weeks in Detroit and over a onth

in Meaford returning to Detroit via Toronto and Wardsville. Archie Huntsman & wife and Nellie Huntsman went to England & Scotl and in spring returning last of September. War with Germany broke out Aug 14. Will Stirling pays P. T. \$40 a month
