

B. E. F. France Oct. 13 1918

Dear Mrs McArthur

Tonight we have heard that Germany has accepted our terms It seems to good to beleive To think that the troops going up the line now may be the last! One of my first thoughts was for you and how glad you would be. You will not need to give your boy if this is really true It is simply to wonderful for words. We had a Thanksgiving service tonight How the boys sang! I wish you could have heard them.

This is not a letter, only a note I will Write a real one soon. I am still with the British C.C.S.* since joining them I have moved about a great deal. Arras Bapaume, Vimy, Albert, Doullens are Amongst The places seen some day I will tell you about them all

Our men have done splendidly I hope to see The ground just gained in a day or two. The guns are banging away just as the peace terms were not being discussed.
